Lessons are designed for grades Pre-K to 8, and provide fun and valuable lessons taught by MMWA's School Education Coordinator. All lessons meet specific Michigan Benchmarks and Standards in various disciplines and focus on the 4R's – reduce, reuse, recycle and re-buy.

**The Incredible Edible Landfill** teaches students about the history of garbage and landfills and culminates in the creation of an edible landfill model.

**Worms Eat Our Garbage** will get students squirming to learn about how redworms can play a part in reducing the amount of organic waste sent to landfills by building and maintaining a classroom worm bin.

Students journey through the life cycle of a piece of paper in **Recycled Paper: Start to Finish** and get hands-on to experience the recycling process by making new paper from old.

**Garbage Pizza** helps students understand America's trash through a hands-on trash sort and teaches them ways to reduce their waste.

**The Green Goods** lesson teaches students how recyclable materials are transformed into new "green" products by investigating the recycling process and new product production. They'll also learn how to identify a product made from recycled materials.
